NATIONAL WESTERN STOCK SHOW

- Events are starting to come fast at the complex.

- Stock Show tickets will go on sale in September, and we are receiving inquiries daily, so interest seems to be strong.

- **Pursuing bond projects.** We are partnering with NWCO to request that the future Arena and the rehabilitation of the 1909 Stadium Building (to prepare it to house a public food market) be included in the November GO Bond. CSU and WSSA are lending their support to the request.
- **CAC tour.** The Authority participated in the Citizens’ Advisory Committee’s first look at the under-construction campus, with an overview of the Authority’s role and the future outlook for the center.

COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY

- Vertical construction has begun on the final building of the CSU Spur campus, the water-themed building, Hydro. The “topping out” ceremony (where the last steel beam is placed) will likely be in August—stay tuned for more information.
- CSU Fort Collins will offer a dual enrollment course, Horticulture 100, as part of an on-going partnership with Bruce Randolph School – the middle school/high school neighboring Spur. CSU has also advised in the creation of a Denver Public Schools AgConnect pathway (piloting at BRS this Fall) and partnered to bring a new Big Green teaching garden to the school
- The CSU System is recruiting two high school students with connections to 80216 to participate in a new summer internship program designed by the Youth Action Team. Please see the flyers for the Education Team Internship and the External Relations Team Internship for more information.
